## Completion Instructions for the Biotech Yield Endorsement Seed Dealer Certification Statement

Only purchases of qualifying hybrid corn seed shall be recorded on the Biotech Yield Endorsement Seed Dealer Certification Statement. Do not include purchases of any other corn seed.

Each insured on the BYE Seed Dealer Certification Statement that is eligible for, and wishes to obtain, the Pilot BYE premium rate reduction is responsible for both of the following:

- ensuring the accuracy of their information
- providing FMH a copy of both the following on or before the acreage reporting date:
  - a completed, signed and dated BYE Seed Dealer Certification Statement(s) and Insured Certification Statement.
  - purchase and return seed invoices that substantiate the information provided on the BYE Seed Dealer Certification Statement.

FMH will need a copy of the seed dealer's certification and seed receipts for each producer who purchased seed. For example, a tenant has two landlords who purchase part of the seed planted on their acreage; the tenant will need to submit three different seed dealer certifications and seed receipts.

### Instructions on filling out the seed dealer certification form

1. **Seed Dealer's Name, Address and Phone:** Enter complete name, address and phone number of the seed dealer from which the qualifying hybrid corn seed was purchased.
2. **Monsanto Technology Agreement Number:** Monsanto Technology Stewardship Agreement Number of the person who purchased the qualifying hybrid seed used to qualify for the Pilot BYE. This may or may not be the insured. A separate seed dealer certification must be completed for each seed purchaser.
3. **Total Number of Units of Qualifying Hybrid Corn Seed Purchased:** List the total net (amount purchased minus amount returned) number of units of qualifying hybrid corn seed received by the seed purchaser for the crop year. A unit of seed equals 80,000 kernels. A mini bulk unit of 4 million kernels shall consist of 50 units.
4. **Seed Purchaser's Name and Phone:** Enter the complete name (proper name and not nickname) and phone number of the person who purchased the qualifying hybrid corn seed.
5. **Insured's Name:** Enter the complete name (proper name and not nickname) of the insured. If the insured is the same as the seed purchaser, it is not necessary to enter the insured's name.
6. **Insured's Policy Number:** List the policy number of the underlying APH, CRC or RA corn policy of the insured.
7. **State:** Enter the state where the qualifying hybrid corn seed was planted.
8. **Crop Year:** The crop year for which the qualifying hybrid corn seed was purchased.

9. County: The county where the qualifying hybrid corn seed was planted.
10. Seed Company: The name of the seed company of the qualifying hybrid corn seed received by the insured/producer. If the insured received seed produced by different companies, each company must be entered separately.
11. Seed Hybrid: The name of the seed hybrid received by the insured/producer. If the insured/producer received multiple seed hybrids, each hybrid must be entered separately. A list of qualifying hybrids is available at [www.biotechyieldendorsement.com](http://www.biotechyieldendorsement.com)
12. Insured/Producer: List all producers by hybrid that will share in the crop planted to qualifying BYE seed regardless of whether those producers are insured. When a producer shares with multiple entities, please list each relationship separately. For example, a tenant who has 100% interest in acreage, and also two landlords he crop shares with would have three line entries under his name. The tenant should not combine them all and report as one entry.
13. Share Interest: The share interest of the producer must be the same as the share division of the crop. It is not the share interest of how the seed was purchased.
14. Total Units (Before Share): Report the total units planted on acreage regardless of share.
15. Number of Units of Seed: This reports the amount of units after share and is calculated by multiplying Share Interest by Total Units. (Column E x Column F)
16. Approximate per Acre Seeding Rate: List the approximate plant population the producer planted.
17. Approximate BYE Acres Seeded: This is calculated by taking 80,000 seeds (1 unit) divided by approximate per acre seeding rate (column H) multiplied by number of units of seed (column G).
18. Total Number of Units of Seed: Sum the number of units entered under column G (Number of Units of Seed). This figure must equal the number reported in Item 3 of Number of Units of Qualifying Hybrid Corn Seed Purchased.
19. Total Approximate BYE Acres Seeded: Sum the number of units entered under column I (Approximate BYE Acres Seeded). This is the approximate number of BYE acres which were seeded. This number will be entered into eCrop for verification purposes.
20. Seed Dealer Employee/Owner Name (Print) Print the name of the employee or owner of the seed dealer who will sign the BYE Seed Dealer Certification Statement.
21. Seed Dealer Employee/Owner Signature: Signature of the employee or owner of the seed dealer.
22. Date: Date the employee or owner of the seed dealer signed the BYE Seed Dealer Certification Statement.
